School Procedures

From Monday 10th September the procedures for arriving and departing school will be changing. The main gate will be opened at 8.50am and the children will go straight into school when they arrive. Staff will be available at the school doors for 10 minutes if parents wish to briefly talk to staff members. For longer discussions please book an appointment with the class teacher via the teacher or by emailing the office. All children need to arrive by 9.00am otherwise they will be marked as late on the registers. At Foston the main gate will be locked at 9.10am and the side entrance should be used via the staff carpark. At the end of the school day all children will remain in the school building until parents are visible on the playground. Please can we ask that everyone waits for the children in the playground otherwise children will remain in the school building.

The Country Mile is a parent led activity insured through our Friends of Terrington School group and will commence on Monday 10th Sept, 08.40-08.55hrs. It will be 15mins of exercise for any pupils and parents/grandparents/carers wanting to join in, be it running, jogging or walking around the meadow.

There will be no time for the children to change afterwards so although they will need to be in school uniform it may be a good idea to bring dry socks and shoes to change in to due to the morning dew.

The school cannot take responsibility for any accidents acquired during the Country Mile and children must be supervised at all times by yourselves. From a safety point of view please could you ensure that all children are in the meadow and not the car park.
